

White Rock Local Market Inc., 2010 Rules of Operation

1. The 2010 White Rock Local Market operates on the second and fourth Saturday of the month, from March to October. In November and December there will be only one monthly market, on the second Saturdays. Every market will include food/farmers/growers. Only the “second Saturday” market will include non-food, arts and crafts etc.
2. The hours of operation are from 8:00 AM until 1:00 PM, unless announced ahead of time. There will be no rescheduling due to bad weather.
3. Vendors may begin arriving at 6:00 AM to set up and be ready to greet their customers for the opening of the market at 8:00 AM. Vendors need to unload and move vehicles as soon as possible, 7:45am at the latest.
4. To prevent taking valuable parking spaces away from businesses at the shopping center, and from WRLM customers, parking for vendors is behind the shopping center, along the rear of the MRI and Chiropractor section of the shopping center.
5. A standard vendor space is 10 feet X 10 feet. Vendor cost is \$25 per space per market day. Space fees must be paid to the market representative before the end of the market each day.
6. Vendors must supply their own tents, tables, chairs, space signage, refrigeration, storage, and all materials and containers for customer sales.
7. Vendors determine the pricing and display of their products.
8. Vendors shall be solely responsible for damages resulting from the sale of unsafe or unsound goods at the market.
9. No smoking is allowed at the market.
10. Designation and allocation of vendor spaces are the responsibility and at the discretion of the market representative. Spaces shall be sold as the applications are received and approved, until the market is at capacity.
11. Vendors shall, if applicable, have a Sales Tax Certificate or any applicable licenses and permits available for inspection at their market booth. It is the vendor’s responsibility to comply with the State Comptroller’s requirements.
12. All vendors who sell at WRLM must grow, produce, or make 60% of what they sell. All vendors must come from within 150 miles of the market. WRLM excludes distributors from selling at the market. Exceptions to this rule must be proposed to organizers of the White Rock Local Market.
13. All persons or their designated representatives who grow or produce food, agricultural or other products, which have met the guidelines established in the White Rock Local Market Rules of Operation, are eligible to sell at the market.
14. Vendors may share a booth, however each vendor must apply separately and pay the \$25 daily fee to market representatives.
15. White Rock Local Market accepts vendors from the following categories:
 - a. Farmers and growers of vegetables, fruit, nuts, seeds or grains, and horticultural plants and goods.
 - b. Food Specialty, including baked goods, candies, jams, jellies, spices, condiments, cheeses, eggs, milk, honey, meats, and pasta.
 - c. Arts and crafts, hand-made and homemade clothing, pottery, and other items subject to approval from WRLM organizers.

16. Vendors shall be subject to inspection of their farm or place of production at any time.
17. Vendors shall comply with all applicable City Of Dallas, State of Texas and federal ordinances and/or regulations.
18. Violation of any provision of the Rules of Operation shall be a material breach and default by the vendor. The market representative shall reserve the right to cancel any vendor's participation at any time if and when the vendor shall be found to be in violation of any market rule or eligibility requirements.
19. The market shall reserve the right to revise the Market Rules of Operation at any time and shall post notice of such revision to vendors.
20. All persons wanting to sell at the White Rock Local Market must agree to the terms of these rules and show their agreement by signing the application and submitting other required forms, if applicable.
